ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
Nethergate, Nafferton

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Nethergate, Nafferton between its junctions with Howe Lane and New Bridge Lane. During the following period;

07:00hrs Monday 5th August 2019 until 12:00hrs Monday 5th August 2019

The road closure is necessary to enable carriageway surface dressing works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 5 hours.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:

Coppergate, Middle Street, Priestgate, Station Road, New Bridge Lane,

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all traffic but access will be maintained for emergency vehicles, pedestrians and properties affected by the closure.
